Special Items Requested From Home:

After half term we will be: thinking about plants and growing. We will be identifying what a plant needs to enable it to grow. We will be looking at the flowers, plants and greenery around school to identify the similarities and differences between these.

In Literacy we will be: sharing the story 'Jasper's Beanstalk'. In our writing, we will be writing about the story. We will also be continuing to practise recording CVC/CVCC/CCVC words independently. We will be continuing to focus on hearing the initial sounds in words, as well as stretching words to record all of the sounds that we can hear. In Phonics, we will be revisiting the sounds j, v, w, and y. We will be focussing on the formation of these and using these within words. We will also be looking at the tricky words: he, she, me, we, be, was, they, are, you and her; practicing the recognition of these.

In Mathematics we will be: thinking about number bonds to 10. We will be singing rhymes to help us remember what numbers go together to make 10. We will be using part – whole models to help us represent the different number bonds to 10.

And finally:

- We would like to say 'well done' to the children for a fantastic half term. The children have made great progress and we look forward to seeing them refreshed and ready for learning after the half term break.
- Please can we ask that you continue to practise the writing and recognition of sounds in your child's sound wallet, focussing on the correct letter formation and pronunciation of the sounds. Should you require help with this please speak to a member of the foundation stage team.
