
Parent consultations

Before the holidays, we applied for the Tesco Stronger Starts grant and we have been successful - we have asked for money to create our very own sand pit.


Our project will be put forward to a customer vote in Tesco stores. Voting will begin in stores from the first week of October 2023 until Mid-January 2024.
